For those who missed it, there were two big announcements made at the January meeting.

The first, which you probably have heard by now, is that **Central Plains Novelty** is closing. After 27 years Nancy & Zandra have decided to move on to other things. Their last day open will be March 1st, 2014. We wish them good luck!

The second big announcement was that the **Greenway Alliance** has decided that Delano's **Pearl Street Path** should be their 2014 project. This is great news for a lot of reasons, but mainly because this group gets things done!

In case you are unfamiliar with the Greenway Alliance, they are the people who helped get **Botanica** started and they also were of great help in getting our Longhorn set in place (watch for native grass to be planted around him soon).

Now some of you are probably asking "What's the **Pearl Street Path**?" One of the elements in the **Delano Revitalization Plan** was to turn the abandoned railway corridor into a multi-use path. The land was originally platted as Pearl Street so that became the name of the path.

The path will run from Seneca to McLean and connect up to Delano Park at the east end. We will be meeting with the Greenway Alliance at the end of February to discuss our ideas and lay out some initial plans of what the path should be like.

Watch for a public meeting sometime in the spring. We will keep you informed of the plans as this project progresses.
